

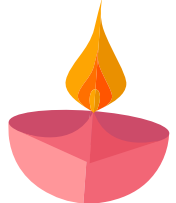

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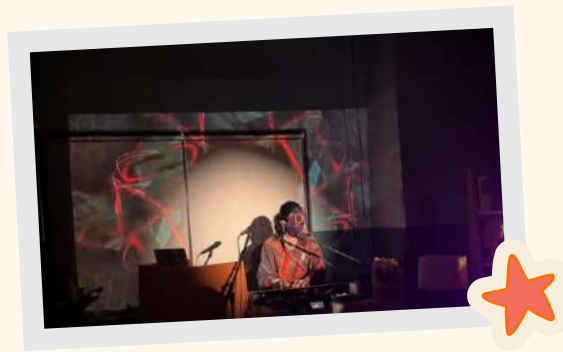

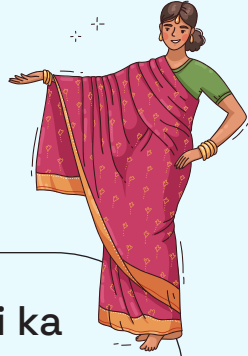

First, throw out that junk. I know you have some purani magazines and random plastic bags lying around. If you haven't touched it in a year, kya zaroorat hai? Dump it!

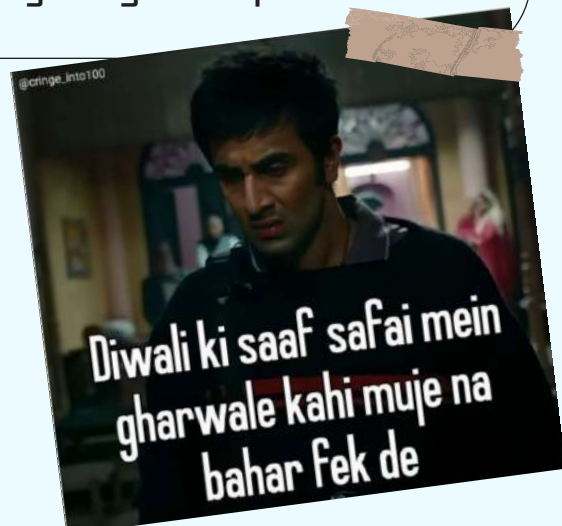
Use nimbu pani (lemon water) with a pinch of salt to clean your kitchen counters. Top notch safai, okay?
